Shipyards Park: Designed to be enjoyed year round, it's a large open space that lends itself to a multitude of activities. Included in your park booking is the Fireplace Room, parking lot, and stage. *Please note that even though you have booked Shipyards Park/Fireplace Room exclusively for your event the Fireplace Room needs to remain open to the public during the public hours of operation.

Fireplace Room (Located in the Frank Slim Building in Shipyards Park): The Fireplace Room is open to the public from 11:00 am – 4:00 pm daily and is not an exclusive use area during this time. The Fireplace Room can be booked outside of the public hours of operation. There is a 4 hour minimum booking. If the rental follows the public hours of operation, the 4 hour minimum may be reduced. The Fireplace Room is 825 square feet and has a propane fireplace, tables, chairs and washrooms. Maximum capacity is 50 people. Booking does not include the kitchen.

Gazebo and Riverfront Firepits: The firepits are available for rent during and/or after the public hours of operation. There is a 4 hour minimum booking if the rental is outside the public hours of operation. A parks attendant will start, monitor and extinguish the fire; firewood is included. If the rental is during or follows the public hours of operation, the 4 hour minimum can be reduced. The washrooms are available in the Frank Slim Building during your booking but the Fireplace Room will remain locked. The Fireplace Room can be booked simultaneously with your firepit booking if available. Hourly rates apply to this additional booking.

Exclusive Use in Designated Areas: The Use of City Parks and Paved Trails Policy makes it possible for businesses and groups to book space for exclusive use in all City parks and paved trails.

A business with 10 or more participants need to register, pay the hourly fee and provide a copy of business license and insurance to use these public spaces.

A group with 10 or more participants needs to register for use of these public spaces to avoid potential conflicts.

Who was Frank Slim?

Frank Slim was the only Yukon First Nations person to earn riverboat captain's papers. For over 30 years, Slim guided steamboats up and down the major rivers of B.C., Alaska and the Yukon. In 1960, he had the honour of piloting the Keno on its last voyage from Whitehorse to Dawson. Frank Slim and his many accomplishments have been honoured in the Yukon Transportation Hall of Fame at the Yukon Transportation Museum. The park's connection with First Nations and the history of the area being used as a Shipyard led to this choice.
