## MINUTES - DRAFT

- 1.0 Welcomed members and everyone signed in.
- 2.0 Reviewed and approved amended minutes from previous meeting.
- 3.0 Finalized recommendations for possible MMU use on Rotary Centennial Bridge - All
  - Some constrictions, more education, yes to MMU traffic as a corridor only not the whole Millennium Trail MMU.
  - No gates, yes to MMU traffic as a corridor not necessarily on the RCB but if yes, only not the whole Millennium Trail MMU. Provide legal access.
  - RCA provided a recommendation from a recent Directors meeting to maintain non-motorized status of the bridge and possibly better gates, cameras and limiting access on the west side of the bridge. RCA resolution attached.
  - City should provide a way across the river for MMU traffic but do not recommend use of RCB due to mixing of uses.
  - Lights on the bridge to denote MMU travel and warn all users on the bridge.
  - Use of cameras or trail counters to determine if this is a real need or not. Evaluate revised status of MMU on EYR due to new designations. Support existing use.
  - Due to meager EYR MMU routes, provide MMU access across the RCB with a limited route. Trail on west side to be upgraded to accommodate MMU and speed control. No gates.
  - Traffic calming initiatives for bridge based on other municipalities and their experiences.
  - Consideration for a new pedestrian bridge across river.
  - PCCA provided a recommendation and recognize need to cross the river with MMU but not in support of using the RCB. Best use of bridge is non-motorized.
- 4.0 Discussed trail development application (Paul Burbidge) – All
  - Generally acceptable application, consensus vote, approved.
