2018 Municipal Election Proxy Procedures

Eligible electors may vote by proxy if they are going to be out of town during the period between Nomination Day and Polling Day (September 27 to October 18, inclusive).

To vote by proxy:

1. Choose someone you trust to vote on your behalf (your proxy). This person must also be an eligible elector.
2. Complete the top portion of the “Application to Vote by Proxy” form and have your proxy voter complete the “consent” portion of the application
3. Return the completed proxy application to the Election Office at City Hall

Election staff will verify that both the applicant and the proxy voter are eligible electors, and then a Proxy Certificate will be issued for the proxy voter.

An elector may serve as a proxy only once during an election.

To exercise the proxy, the proxy voter **MUST** bring the Proxy Certificate to the Election Office at City Hall and vote by Special Ballot.

Proxy certificates will **NOT** be accepted at a regular polling place.

Special Ballots will be available at City Hall during regular office hours beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 2nd until 2:00 p.m. on October 18th.

When a voter presents a proxy certificate at the Election Office, staff will ask for identification and require the proxy voter to swear or affirm the “declaration” portion of the proxy certificate. The Certificate must then be surrendered to the Election Office. Once this is done, the proxy voter will be issued a ballot.

Proxy voters who come to City Hall to exercise a proxy may also vote on their own behalf at that time if they choose to do so. Proxy voters are eligible for a special ballot.

PLEASE NOTE: Every eligible elector who wishes to vote by proxy must appoint his or her own proxy. If you and your spouse/partner are both eligible and will both be away during the election, you will each have to appoint a different proxy voter.
