

# Racquet Sport Guidelines

<b>On Court management:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Each player must use his/her own equipment that they have signed out or brought. No sharing of equipment.</li><li>✓ Balls/shuttlecocks must be passed using racquets or by kicking.</li><li>✓ NO physical contact between players. Consider touching racquets rather than shaking hands.</li><li>✓ Players should not change ends during a match.</li><li>✓ Maximum of 10 people in each 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the Flexihall</li></ul>
<b>Singles or Doubles?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Play only with family members, persons living in your household or individuals you believe to be low risk</li><li>✓ Stay on your side of the court</li></ul>
<b>Seating</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Single chairs only. Single seating only set apart the 2-metre appropriate distance.</li></ul>
<b>Personal Sanitation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Each player should sanitize before entering the Flexihall at the sanitation station.</li></ul>
<b>Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Do not share equipment with others-avoid tapping paddles</li><li>✓ Avoid touching other surfaces</li><li>✓ Avoid touching the nets</li><li>✓ Return borrowed equipment and place in cart labelled dirty at the end of your session to be disinfected by staff</li></ul>
