



How do I registrar trail as Trans Canada Trail ?

Preface: *The T.C.T. name & Logo are registered trade marks and use without written permission is prohibited.*

*In the Yukon Territory the **Klondike Snowmobile Association** is the legal agent for the Trans Canada Trail.*

1st Are you on the official route ?

2nd There are five core user groups for the Trans Canada Trail. Can your proposed trail accommodate no less than two user groups per season.

*3rd. If your trail is on the proposed **Alaska - Yellowstone Recreational Corridor**, can your trail accommodate snowmobiles ?*

4th The more user groups you can accommodate, the higher priority your section of proposed trail will receive.

5th Your trail does not have to be currently 100% built before it is registered but if you do register it you may be eligible for funding assistance if you can open by July 1st, 2000.

6th To qualify for Trans Canada Trail status, you will have to agree to sign the trail to Trans Canada Trail signage guidelines.

7th To qualify for Trans Canada Trail status, you will have to agree to build the trail to at least minium Trans Canada Trail guidelines.

8th You will have to provide written authorization of the land owner that they agree to the land use as *Trans Canada Trail*. (In the case of Y.T.G. land like the Dawson Road for example, a form 2, {Work within a Right-Of-Way}, is sufficient)

9th There can only be one main line *T.C.T.* route. Branch lines can be approved to meet local needs but still have to meet minimum standards.

10th Branch lines are **not** eligible for funding

11th Fill out the application and forward to the *Klondike Snowmobile Association*, attention: P.J. GREENLAW or Myrna ENGREN

In return, we provide;

- written permission for you to use the *T.C.T.* logo & name both on the trail and in advertisement-promotion.

- access to national trail signage at national bulk order pricing

- the *T.C.T.* route markers

- the *Trans Canada Snowmobile Trail* route markers

- trail liability insurance

- financial assistance up to 50% of project cost if you meet the standard
