# Recreation Grants

The City of Whitehorse acknowledges the contribution of the Community Lottery Program for the funding which is distributed through the Recreation Grant process. Valuable community initiatives would not be possible without this support.



## Category 1 – Recreation Grants

Recreation Grants funding is offered to encourage volunteer community groups and organizations in Whitehorse to further improve or develop recreation opportunities for Whitehorse citizens.

**The deadline for Category 1 applications March 15 and September 15 of each year.**

## Category 2 – Recreation Facilities / Parks

Funding may be available for use in ongoing operation and maintenance or staffing costs for non City owned public recreation facilities. Funding is also considered for capital improvements and park enhancement projects.

**The deadline for Category 2 applications March 15 of each year.**

## Category 3 – Arts / Cultural Facilities

Funding may be available for use in ongoing operation and maintenance or staffing costs for non-City owned public facilities of an arts and / or heritage nature.

**The deadline for Category 3 applications is March 15 of each year.**

# Festival and Special Event Grant

Grants and in-kind support are available to community groups and organizations.

**AUGUST 31 is the annual deadline date for the Festivals and Special Event Grant intake for all events scheduled from January to December of the following year.**



# Environmental Grants

Funding is provided to help make progress towards the 12 goals of the Whitehorse Sustainability Plan. Non-profits, businesses, and schools may apply.

**The deadline for grants over \$1,000 is February 15 and October 15 of each year. Applications up to \$1,000 can be made year-round.**
