

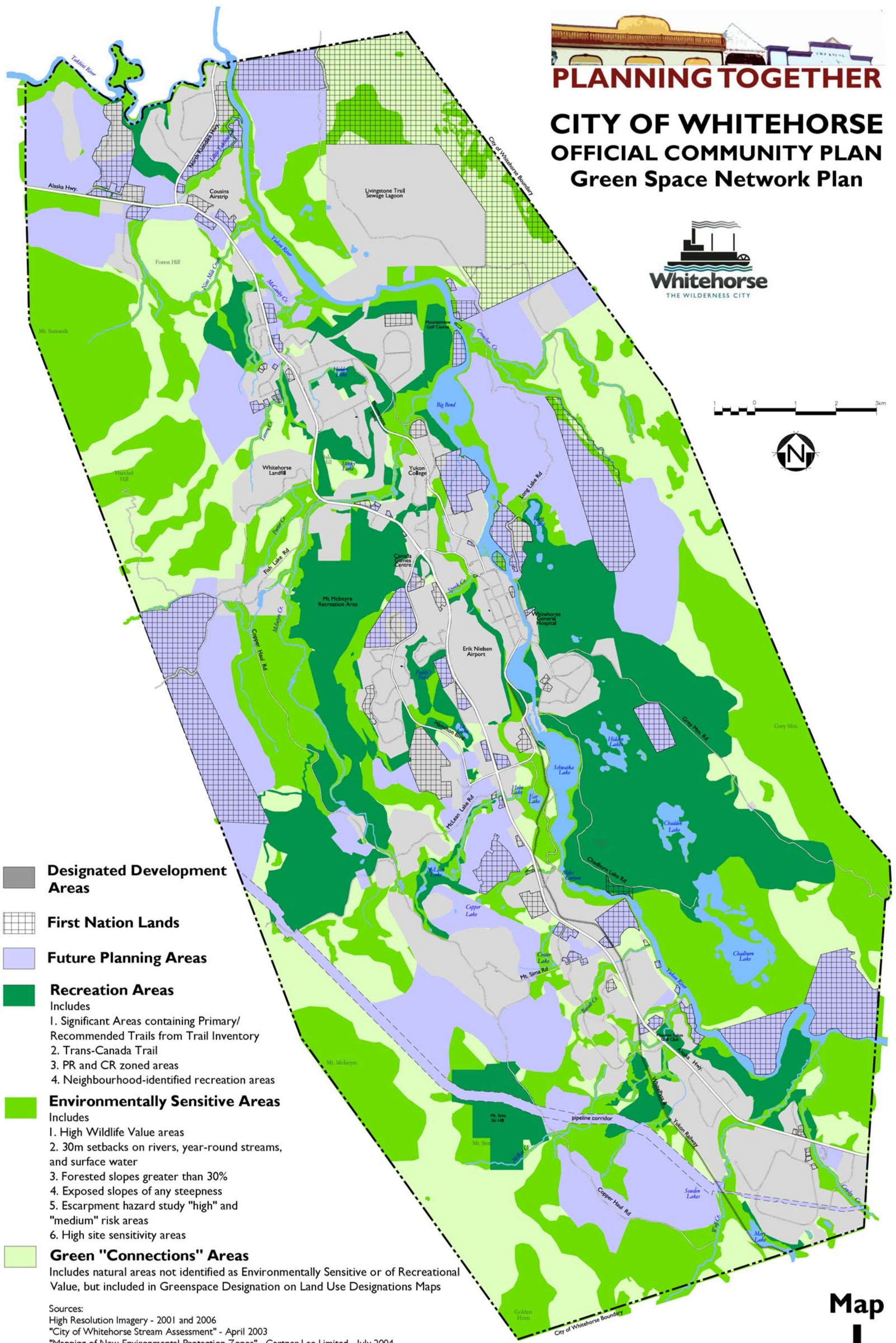

 1. Significant Areas containing Primary/Recommended Trails from Trail Inventory
 2. Trans-Canada Trail
 3. PR and CR zoned areas
 4. Neighbourhood-identified recreation areas
-  **Environmentally Sensitive Areas**
Includes
 1. High Wildlife Value areas
 2. 30m setbacks on rivers, year-round streams, and surface water
 3. Forested slopes greater than 30%
 4. Exposed slopes of any steepness
 5. Escarpment hazard study "high" and "medium" risk areas
 6. High site sensitivity areas
-  **Green "Connections" Areas**
Includes natural areas not identified as Environmentally Sensitive or of Recreational Value, but included in Greenspace Designation on Land Use Designations Maps
