

## Telegraph Office

Address: 1124 First Avenue

Built: 1900

Renovated:

- Circa 1920s-1940s—minor repairs including larger windows and new porch roof
- Circa early 1970s—new foundation and replacement of sill logs
- 2002—porch roof was replaced again and returned to its original form

Designated: Feb. 28, 2011

- One of the first buildings to be constructed in Whitehorse
- One of only two buildings to survive the 1905 fire that razed most of Downtown
- The building represents the founding of the community and the nationally significant Dawson-Ashcroft Telegraph Line
