Address: 3128 Third Avenue (Lepage Park)

Built: circa 1904

Renovated: 1983

- Interior and Exterior renovations/upgrades
- Addition of wood foundation
- Removal of shed roof from west side
- Repaired exterior siding, windows and trims

Designated: Oct. 25, 1999

Named for: Jack Smith

Smith worked as a messenger for the Dominion Telegraph Office

- moved the house to its current location in 1905
- left Whitehorse in 1906 to join his family in Victoria

House had many owners; Following Smith was:

- 1906-1907 - "Billy" Shaw, port steward for B.Y.N.Co.;
- 1907-1909 - William L. Lawton, stable man for White Pass;
- 1909-1923 - A. P. Hawes, veterinarian for White Pass;
- 1923-1941 - John E. French, carpenter and undertaker;
- 1941-1984 – Numerous owners;
- 1984-Present – City of Whitehorse.
