1. Can anyone reassign a sales agreement to another party?

Sale agreements are not assignable. A purchaser under a sale agreement is required to complete the transaction with the City and cannot assign their agreement to another party while under agreement.

2. Can business licenses be revoked?

A business license can be revoked as per Section 50 of the City's Business License Bylaw. An appeal of a revoked business license may be made to Council in writing within 30 days of the notice being given to the business owner.

3. Confirm if the policy is intending to say Yukon health card 'OR' driver's license or 'AND' driver's license?

The proposed policy has been revised to exclude the Yukon Health Care Card. Yukon Government is restricting the use of the health care card for proof of residency purposes as this collides with the *Health Information Privacy and Management Act (HIPMA)* as this information is considered personal health information. Acceptable forms of identification to prove age, identity and residency requirements will be a secure Yukon Driver's License or General Identification Card.
