All the ideas represented in this map are based on comments collected at the Neighbourhood OCP Workshop

Yellow Dots give information on each coloured area

Red Dots represent "hot button" issues

Grey Areas represent places where residents proposed several uses for an area



Yellow Dots

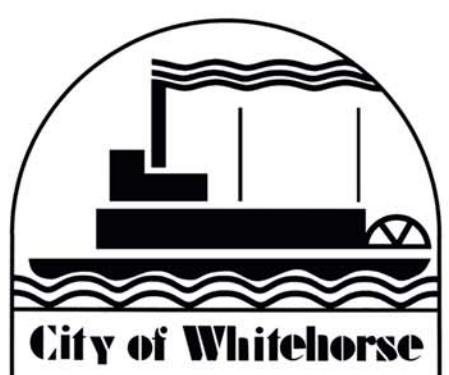
- A - New residential area
- B - Allow quarrying here but convert to residential later
- C - Protect MacPherson and Hidden Valley from any further development, including no new trails
- D - Leave existing neighbourhoods as they are. No subdivision of lots. No new services
- E - Allow existing uses
- F - Support new residential here
- G - Continue to allow future agriculture uses here
- H - Ta'an Kwach'an residential area

Red Dots

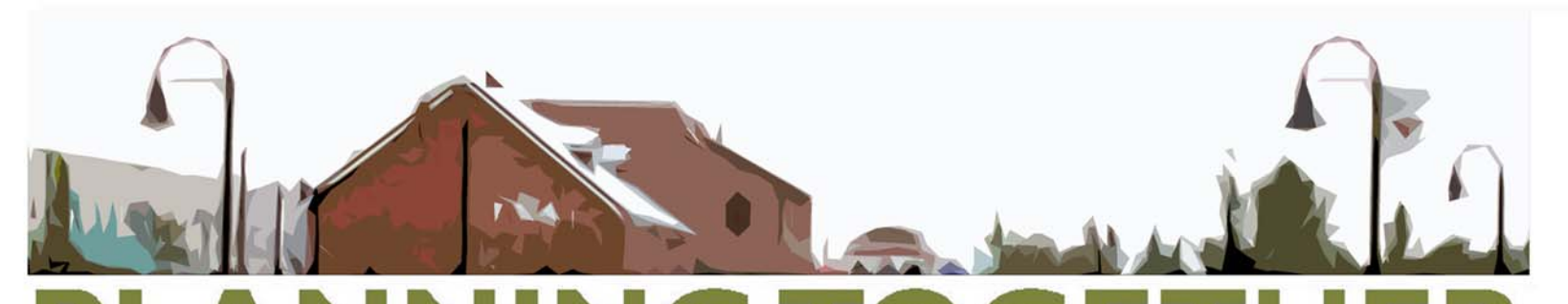
- 1 - Toxic waste in this area, has the potential to leach downstream and is carried by the wind. Needs mitigation
- 2 - This area too steep for development
- 3 - New intersection to service Ta'an Kwach'an development brings traffic safety concerns
