PURPOSE: To streamline the approval process and regulate the temporary

placement of festival tents

AUTHORITY: Council Resolution # 93-22-44 dated July 12, 1993

PLACEMENT OF TEMPORARY TENTS POLICY

All tents placed for seven (7) days or less shall conform to the following:

City Controlled Lands

For all lands and streets owned and or controlled by the City of Whitehorse, the contact person will be the Manager of Parks and Recreation or the City Engineer.

- Land use approved by the Development Officer
- Placement controlled by the Manager of Parks and Recreation or the Engineering Department by a Street Occupancy Permit
- Business License where required
- Inspection by Fire Inspector

All Other Lands

For all other lands the contact person will be the Fire Inspector.

- Permission of land owners
- Land use approve by the Development Officer
- Business License where required
- Inspection by Fire Inspector

All tent placements exceeding seven (7) days shall require the approval of or permits from the Development Officer, Building Inspections, and the Business License Officer.

Note: All departments who may be concerned shall be notified by the contact person.
