

Outdoor freezers need locks on both front corners.



Keep your recycling inside until the day of collection.



Harvest your berries as soon as they are ripe.



Store your carts in a spot that is out of sight of a bear that is cruising down the street or green belt.



Bears are active at night. Put your cart out the morning of collection.



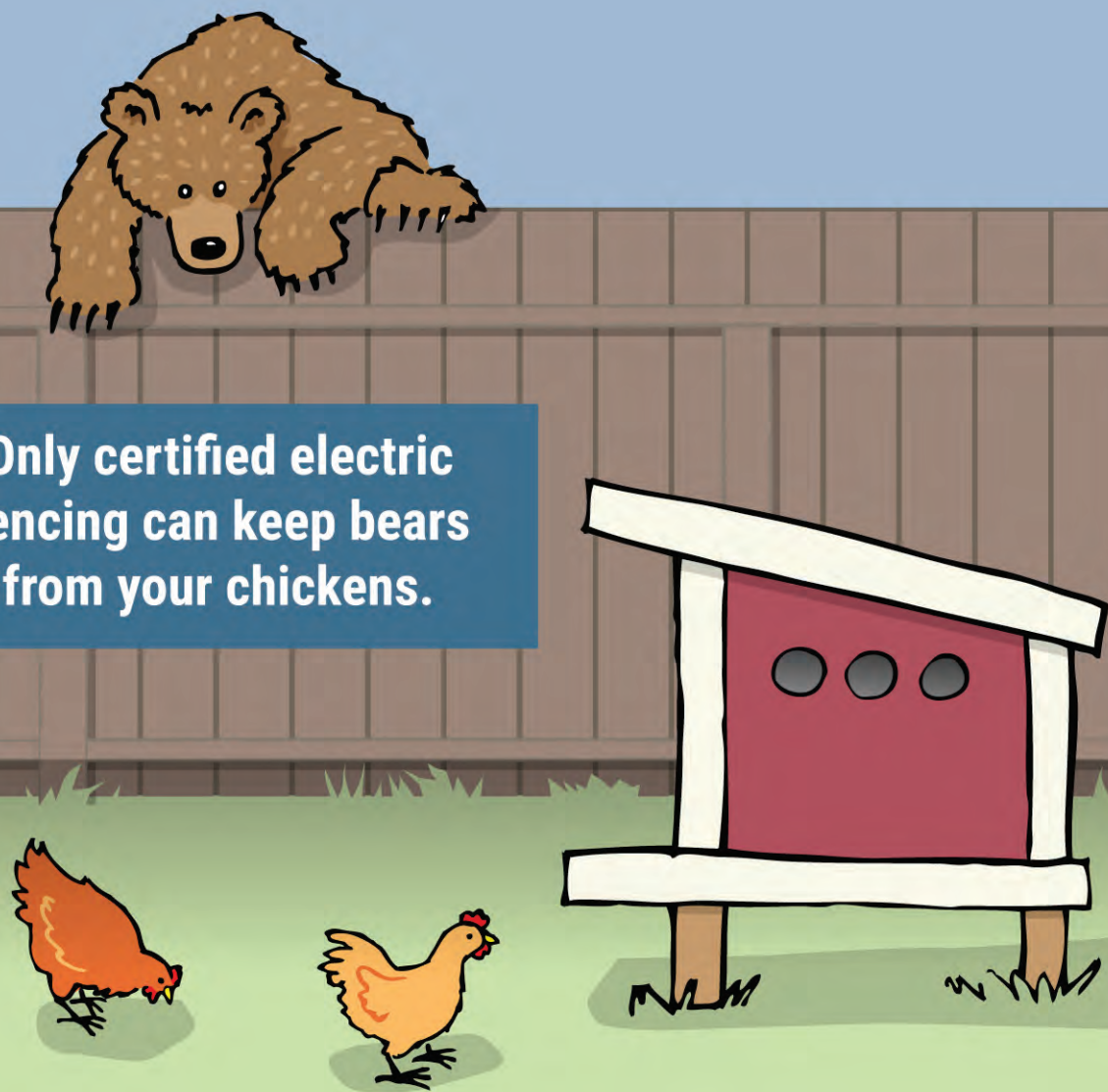
Keep your carts locked in sheds or garages where possible.



Never feed pets outside and clean up after them regularly.



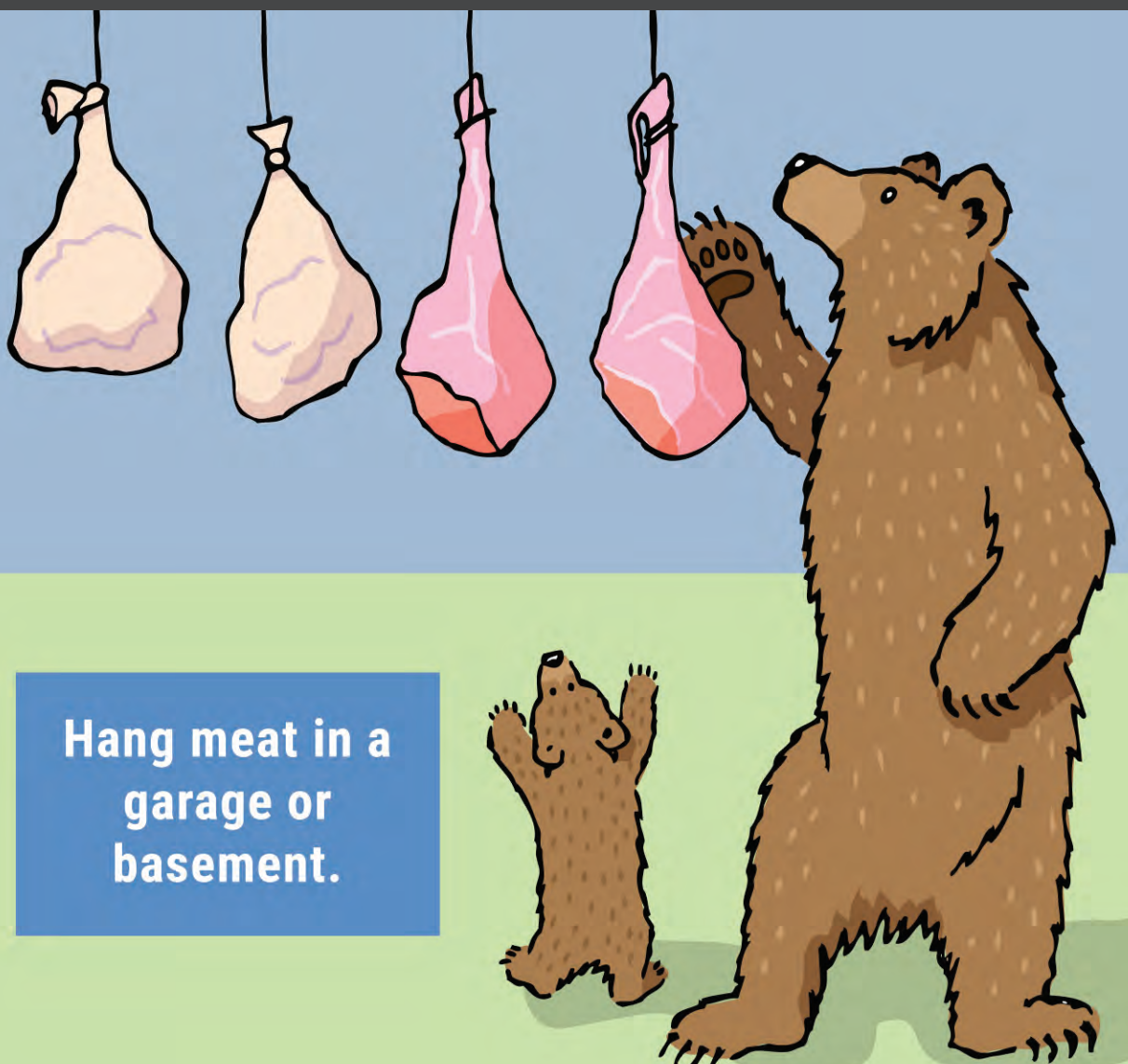
Only certified electric fencing can keep bears from your chickens.



Your garbage carts are NOT bear-resistant. Learn what you can do to reduce conflict.



Hang meat in a garage or basement.



Clean BBQs and smokers regularly. Ideally, store in a locked shed or garage.



Put feeders away from April to late October.
