 Confirm that basic project information is satisfactory City identifies requirements for complete application (especially whether anything more or less than standard checklist is required) Applicant has opportunity to ask questions, clarify regulations/requirements prior to submission of complete application. 				
Process				
A request for pre-application review can be made once the proponent has determined the proposed use, intensity of use (GFA, number of residential units, etc.), and has prepared preliminary site, building and drainage/servicing plans. The Development Officer will determine whether to provide written comments and recommendations back to the proponent, or to schedule a meeting. If a meeting is required, it will be scheduled between the project team and key City representatives (Development Officer, Engineering Services, others as appropriate) to review the project details.
