### 1. Chilkoot Way Active Transportation Improvements - For Information Only

Through community engagement on the proposed 2040 Official Community Plan (January 2023) (OCP), Transportation Master Plan, and multiple Capital and Operating Budget engagements, there has been an increased public demand and desire for improving transportation options and the overall active transportation network. In 2022, Council approved the engineering design and construction for the Chilkoot Way Active Transportation Improvements project to address the active transportation gap between Two Mile Hill and the non-motorized Riverfront pathways.

Administration responded to questions regarding the process and development of the proposed project. Administration also provided clarification regarding details of the proposal with respect to transit stops and accessibility features.

## 1. Public Hearing Report - Zoning Amendment 10 Finch Crescent

The Committee was presented with a Public Hearing Report on a bylaw to amend the Zoning at 10 Finch Crescent. A Public Hearing was held on February 27, 2023. One written submission was received in support of the zoning amendment and one individual spoke in support at the Public Hearing. The owner of 10 Finch Crescent has applied to rezone their property from RR – Restricted Residential Detached to RRx – Restricted Residential Detached (modified) to allow a one storey ground level living suite as a secondary use and increase the maximum site coverage from 35% to 40%. The increase in the maximum site coverage is to accommodate the single storey living suite on the ground level so that it is accessible to facilitate aging in place.

## The Recommendation of the City Planning Committee is

THAT Council direct that Bylaw 2023-01, a bylaw to amend the zoning of 10 Finch Crescent, to allow a one-storey ground level living suite as a secondary use, and to increase the maximum site coverage to 40%, be brought forward for Second and Third Reading under the bylaw process.

### 2. Budget Amendment COVID Wasterwater Testing

The Committee was presented with a request to amend the 2023 Operating Budget to accommodate a funding contribution in the amount of \$150,000 for a Wastewater Surveillance COVID-19 Project. The City entered into an agreement with the Council of Yukon First Nations to receive funding for the coordination, sampling and shipment of raw wastewater samples for COVID-19 virus particles analysis as part of a Health Canada project.

#### The Recommendation of the Corporate Services Committee is

THAT Council amend the 2023 Operating Budget to receive the \$150,000 contribution from the Council of Yukon First Nations, and coordinate the sample collection.

#### 3. New Business - MSB Building Update

A Committee member requested an update regarding the future of the Municipal Services Building. Administration confirmed that the building is a surplus to the needs of the City of Whitehorse and that Administration will be bringing forward a request to dispose of the property.
