

Curbside Collection Sorting Guide 2024

When organic material decomposes in our landfill, it creates methane, a potent greenhouse gas.
However, when you put organics in your Green Cart, we make valuable compost!
Practices non-compliant with the Waste Management Bylaw are subject to fines.

COMPOSTABLES

No Plastics, Metal, Boxboard, E-waste or Pet Waste

All food

Including meat, bones, fish and dairy products raw or cooked



Other

Human and pet hair, sawdust and wood shavings, plant trimmings and dried leaves, coffee grounds and filters, tea bags

Yard waste

If possible, keep extra yard and garden waste bags to **4 per collection day**

Food-soiled cardboard and paper products

Such as pizza boxes and donut boxes. Soiled tissues, napkins and paper towel.

Biodegradable is not the same as compostable.

Some biodegradable materials contain plastics which do not break down properly in a composting environment.

No plastic in your Green Cart!

Still want to use bags?

Use paper bags, or certified compostable bags. Look for these logos to ensure they can compost.



Tip: Use bags in the winter season to help prevent the cart from freezing!

Extra yard waste that doesn't fit in your Green Cart?

Use paper yard bags or bags with the above logos. No heavier than 25 kg.

Sticks under 1.5 cm in diameter are allowed.



GARBAGE

No Compostables, E-waste, Hazardous Waste, Biomedical Waste or Cardboard

Non-recyclable packaging



Other

Cigarettes, gum,

foil, vacuum cleaner

incandescent/halogen

bulbs and plastic wrap.

bags and contents,

Non-beverage glass

(Bring beverage containers to a recycling depot)



Hygiene products



Put cold wood ashes, invasive species and pet waste in a sealed bag for disposal.





Bring E-Waste to a local E-Waste depot for free drop-off.



Place extra bags together at the curb
