
Draft Mineral Exploration Process (Proposed Bylaw 2024-23)





The following process chart may not apply to Type 1 / Category A lands.



Prior to the Exploration Notice Process, the applicant should confirm the OCP designation and zoning of their claim area with the City. If the project is not compliant with the OCP designation, the applicant will need to apply for an amendment after the Exploration Notice Process.
