Transit Fare Changes

Changes to Transit fares will come into effect on Tuesday, July 1.

Cash fares will be \$3.

Ticket strips of 10 tickets will be:

- \$28 for adults
- \$21 for students/youth, ages 5-18
- \$12 for elders/seniors, ages 60+, or those with disabilities (subject to eligibility)

Monthly passes will be:

- \$75 for adults
- \$56 for students/youth
- \$33 for elders/seniors or those with disabilities.

Up to two children under the age of 5 can ride for free with an accompanying adult. Youth fares apply for any additional children.

Use the **Token Transit** app to purchase bus tickets or passes.

Parking Fee Updates

Updates to parking regulations will come into effect Tuesday, July 1. Among the changes, meter fees will be 50 cents for 15 minutes with meters in effect from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday.
