## **E-Permitting Improvements**

The City's e-permitting system now allows for mobile text notifications when an application status changes.

Notifications will automatically be sent to all users who have provided a cell phone number in their online profile. Users can update their profile to change contact information or to opt-out of the notification service.

Email notifications will continue to be used to inform applicants about status changes in their permit applications. These notifications will come from noreply-cityworks@whitehorse. ca.

This is part of the City's ongoing work to improve the e-permitting system.
