### **Fourth Avenue Resurfacing**

Resurfacing work on Fourth Avenue between Ogilvie Street and Second Avenue is scheduled to start on Monday, September 15. The work is expected to take two weeks to complete. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction for periods of time. Cyclists are advised to plan alternative routes and transit riders can expect delays.

#### **Expedited Foundation-only Permits**

The City is expediting Foundation-only Permits for eligible residential projects throughout the rest of the 2025 construction season. This will allow builders to apply for permits for excavation, servicing, footings, and foundation work for new residential buildings. To be eligible, applicants need to meet certain conditions. Visit whitehorse.ca/building for more information to see if your project qualifies.

#### **Environmental Grants**

Environmental Grants support community projects that promote active transportation, heating efficiency, local food production, and more. The next application deadline for grants of \$1,000+ is Wednesday, October 15. Visit whitehorse.ca/grants to learn more.
