Most City facilities and services will be closed Tuesday, November 11 for Remembrance Day. The Canada Games Centre will be open with reduced hours from 1-6 pm. Weekend service will be in effect for Transit, the Waste Management facility will be open, and curbside collection will continue as normal for Downtown, Marwell, Takhini, Valleyview, Hillcrest, Arken, Granger, Ingram. Recycling that would normally be collected November 11 will be collected on Monday, November 10.
