On The Move

A number of city departments will be moving to the Whitehorse Operations Building at 187 Range Road in the coming months. Land and Development Services as well as Building Services will operate out of the Operations Building starting on January 12. Planning and Sustainability Services will move in at the beginning of March. Work has been underway to expand the Operations Building for up to 70 employees as part of the City's efforts to consolidate departments.

Senior Utility Rebate

Applications for the Senior Utility Rebate close on Wednesday, December 31. The rebate is available to Whitehorse residents aged 65 and older, or to eligible surviving spouses.
