Cart at curb by 7 am (off by 11 pm)




Wheels against the curb



Violation of the *Waste Management Bylaw* can result in fines.

## Organics

**No plastic bags, recycling, garbage, e-waste or pet waste**



### All food

Meat, bones, fish and dairy products (raw or cooked)



### Food-soiled cardboard and paper products

Pizza and donut boxes, soiled napkins, paper towel



### Yard waste

No rocks, sod, soil or dirt.

Sticks under 1.5 cm in diameter are allowed.

Bring larger brush to the Waste Management Facility.

### Extra yard waste that doesn't fit in your Green Cart?

Use paper yard bags or bags with these official compostable logos.

If possible keep extra yard and garden waste bags to **4 per collection day**.



Place extra yard waste bags together at the curb. Must be under 25 kg. Damaged or heavy bags will not be collected.

## Garbage

**No organics, recycling, hazardous waste, e-waste or biomedical waste**

Please bag cold wood ashes, pet waste and invasive plants prior to disposal.

### Other

Cigarettes, gum, used vacuum bags, hygiene products, dirty foil and incandescent/halogen bulbs

Please bring bulky items to the Waste Management Facility for drop-off.



### Manage your attractants

**Secure your carts between collections and do not overfill.**


