Paratransit Survey Extended

The deadline for the City's Paratransit Survey is extended to Monday, March 16. The survey is part of the update underway for the Handy Bus Policy (to be renamed Paratransit Policy). We're asking for community input to help guide policy updates and make sure they are informed by the lived experiences of Transit users in Whitehorse. Community Safety and Well-being Plan

The City and Yukon government are developing a Community Safety and Well-being Plan for Whitehorse. The plan will focus on improving safety and well-being for residents. A survey is being conducted by the Canadian Centre for Safer Communities that will help determine local safety concerns, identify key priorities, and shape future initiatives as the plan is developed. Heritage Incentive

Property owners of eligible heritage buildings are invited to apply for funding under the City's Heritage Incentive Policy. The incentive provides funding for up to 50 per cent, to a maximum of \$20,000, for conservation work on designated Municipal Historic Sites. Application deadline is Wednesday, April 1.
