Commercial Organics Collection	Large volume – 2 yard bin – weekly collection	280.50	per bin / per month

Compost sales begin each year in spring. Visit www.whitehorse.ca/compost for more information on purchasing bulk and bagged products.

How to avoid unsorted load fees (\$315.00/tonne) and per item fees (\$50/item):

1. **Sort waste.** Waste must be separated into the categories below for special burial, composting, or recycling at the Waste Management Facility. **The items below will trigger unsorted fees if mixed in with other residual or controlled waste.**

- Clean corrugated cardboard – bring recyclable packaging and paper products to Raven Recentre for free disposal.
- Clean wood waste, brushing - unpainted pallets and wood without treatment, stain, paint, or glue
- Organic waste including all food waste, food scraps, food-soiled paper, leaf and yard waste
- Scrap metals including appliances without refrigerant (dishwashers, stoves, ranges, laundry machines)
- Appliances and white goods with refrigerant (fridges, freezers, air conditioners)
- Grubbing material: including roots, stumps, embedded logs and branches greater than 1.5cm in diameter
- Manure, kennel material, excreta, and fish processing material.
- Asbestos containing materials
- Animal parts and carcasses – slaughter waste not accepted
- Tires

2. **Remove banned items from waste.** These items are not accepted as waste and require alternative disposal:

- Electronic and electrical waste as listed on the [Designated Materials Regulation](#), including corded and cordless items. These items may be recycled for free at Raven ReCentre – visit www.ravenrecentre.org for more information
- Hazardous waste
 - Residential Household Hazardous Waste (except waste oil, antifreeze, DEF, oil filters) accepted Saturdays at Waste Management Facility
 - Waste oil, antifreeze, DEF and oil filters accepted at KBL Environmental, Monday, Thursday and first Saturday of each month
 - **Commercial hazardous waste must be brought to private disposal facility**
- Bio-medical waste, slaughter waste, liquid waste including sewage, sludge, septic tank pumping and sump waste
- Highly combustible and explosive material
- Radioactive waste, incinerator waste
- Contaminated soil
- Vehicles, including all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles
- Tires on rims not accepted

3. **Lock your bin.**

Prevent illegal dumping by locking your bin. Gravity locks allow you to secure your bin without having to unlock for the waste hauler. Ask your waste hauler to provide a lock for your bin.
