Clean-up Days

From **May 21 to 25**, residential tipping fees at the Whitehorse Waste Management Facility will be waived for self-hauled loads of sorted residential waste.

Fees waived for car or pick-up loads, and small trailers with:

- Residential waste
- Wooden furniture
- Mattresses and box springs
- Construction waste separated from residential waste
- Residential yard waste (loose or in compostable bags)
- Other organic waste

Tipping fees will apply for:

- Metals
- Appliances
- All commercial loads

E-waste should be taken to Raven ReCentre.
