Your Worship, the Public Health and Safety Committee respectfully submits the following report:

1. **Delegate Liam Parfitt – Fire Proofing Increases Biodiversity**

Delegate Liam Parfitt discussed the relationship between wildfire mitigation and biodiversity, emphasizing the benefits of forest thinning within Whitehorse. In response to questions from Committee Members, the delegate discussed forest management practices and opportunities to utilize biomass generated through fireproofing activities.

2. **New Business – Fire Proofing Forest Areas Within the City of Whitehorse**

As requested by a Committee Member, Administration provided an overview of ongoing FireSmart initiatives within the City, including work undertaken by the City's FireSmart Coordinator, neighbourhood programs, and the Government of Yukon's fuel break project. Committee Members discussed opportunities to expand forest thinning and the potential use of biomass generated through fireproofing activities.

3. New Business – Notice of Motion - Letter of Support for the Wild Wolves of Canada Ride for the Arctic Initiative

A Committee Member gave notice of a motion to be considered at the July 7, 2026 Regular Council meeting to provide a letter of support for the Wild Wolves of Canada Ride for the Arctic Initiative.

4. New Business – Off-Leash Dogs and Safety

As requested by a Committee Member, Administration provided an update on ongoing efforts to address concerns related to off-leash dogs, including public education, complaint reporting, enforcement, and the planned review of the Animal Control Bylaw. Committee Members discussed opportunities to improve public awareness and enforcement, as well as potential changes to off-leash areas within the City.

1. Official Community Plan (OCP) Map and Text Amendment – Mineral Exploration

Your Worship, the Development Services Committee respectfully submits the following report:

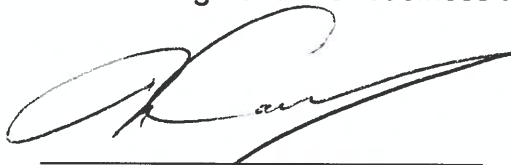
1. Infrastructure Transfer, Operation, and Maintenance Agreement – Ta'an Kwäch'än Council

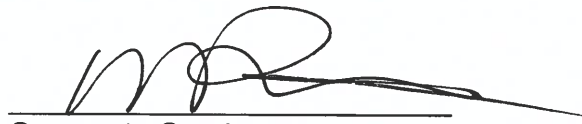
The Recommendation of the Development Services Committee is
