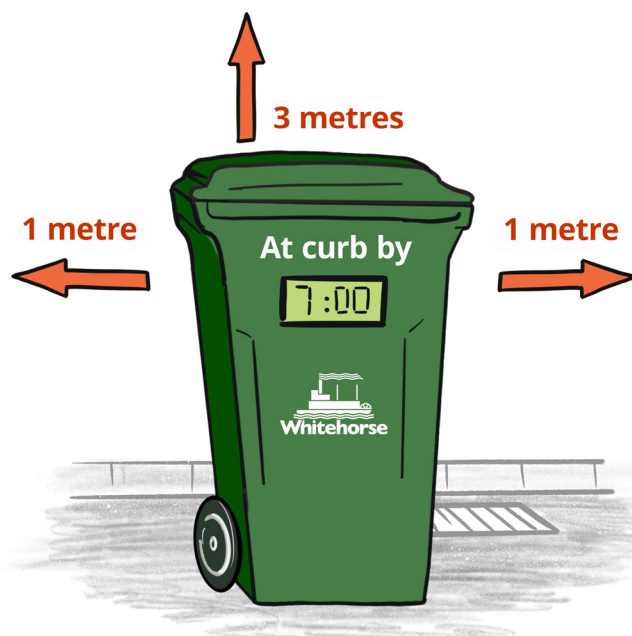


How to Sort Organic Waste



What is Organic Waste?

All food waste is Organic Waste.

- meat
- bones
- shells
- coffee grounds, filters
- tea bags
- dairy products
- fruit, vegetables
- napkins
- food-soiled paper
- compostable containers, cutlery

Add Organic Waste to kitchen catcher.

- Remove all plastic and garbage from your Organic Waste.
- If using a bag in kitchen catcher, use newspaper or a certified compostable bag.

Empty kitchen catcher into Green Cart.

Only put Organic Waste into your Green Cart.

- ✗ no condiment packaging
- ✗ no plastic of any kind
- ✗ no metal or garbage

Green Carts out by 7 am on collection day.

Check side of Green Cart for a sticker which says your collection day. Property owner, manager or designate is responsible for placing cart at curb.

- Minimum 1 metre of space around the Cart.
- Maximum cart weight is 100 kilograms.
